Deans and senior administrators from multiple schools at the same institution are strongly encouraged to attend along with their campus-wide IPE administrator. Participants will leave the program with a leadership action plan to move IPECP efforts forward at their institutions.

- Assess leadership competencies associated with IPE and collaborative practice (CP)
- Identify ways of building senior interprofessional teams to lead IPECP

- Develop approaches to conduct outcomes assessment and evaluate evidence for IPECP
- Engage with colleagues through case studies and models of successful IPECP initiatives
